Terms and Conditions of Entry

3. The Promotion will be open from 1:00 am Australian Eastern Daylight Savings Time ("AEDST") on 18 February 2010 and will continue until 9:00 am AEDST on 15 March 2010 ("Promotion Period").
4. Entry is open to all Australian residents aged 18 years and over, other than management, employees or contractors of the Promoter or Tropfest and other agencies, firms or companies associated with the Promotion (including suppliers of prizes), and their immediate families ("Eligible Entrants").

General
